This is a summary of the post-school pathways of students from Rosella Park School who completed Year 12 and gained a Senior Statement in 2017. The results are from the *Year 12 Completers Survey*, which is conducted approximately six months after students completed Year 12.

One respondent was participating in further education or training, in campus-based study.



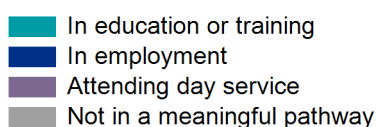
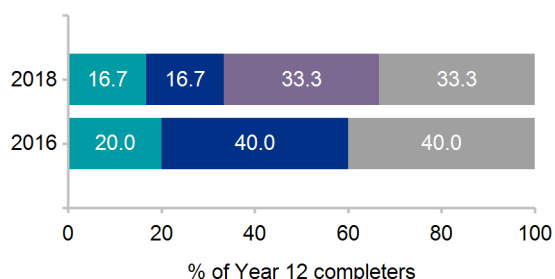
Work was a pathway for one respondent who was doing unpaid or volunteer work.



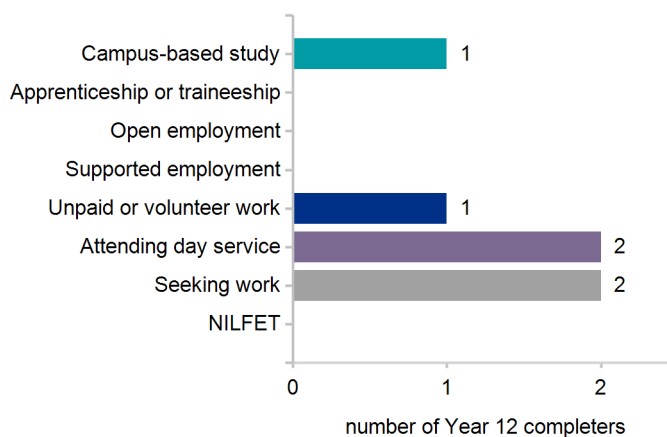
There were two respondents not in education, training or employment but were attending a day service.

The post-school pathways of Year 12 completers from special schools were categorised into eight *main pathways*. Respondents who were in education, training or employment as well as attending a day service were reported in their education, training or employment pathway. These pathways are defined on the next page.

**Post-school pathway categorisation****Education and Training**

Campus-based study <sup>a b</sup>	Studying at Certificate I, II, III, IV, Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Associate Degree or Bachelor Degree level (excluding apprentices and trainees).

**Employment**

Open employment <sup>b</sup>	Undertaking full or part-time work in a non-supported employment environment and not in an education or training category.

Supported employment <sup>b</sup>	Undertaking full or part-time work in a supported employment environment and not in an education or training category.

Unpaid or volunteer work <sup>b</sup>	Undertaking unpaid work—including vocational placements, internships, work experience and trials—or volunteer work.

**Attending day service**

Attending day service	Attending a day service one or more days per week and not in an education, training or employment category.

Seeking work	Looking for work and not in education, training, employment or day service.
