
# **Investing for Success**

## Under this agreement for 2022 Rosella Park School will receive



### This funding will be used to

- Build staff capabilities to embed the use of Augmentative and Alternate Communication as a tool to access curriculum.
- Provide opportunities for teachers and teacher aides to build capabilities to support students with complex communication needs through coaching and professional learning opportunities.
- Provide professional collaboration between staff and external agency to support staff to utilise Roadmap of Communication Competence (ROCC) to develop individual learning goals for students with complex communication needs.
- Review and revise the "Rosella Way" approach to whole school pedagogy by investigating evidencebased research supporting developing whole school approaches to pedagogy.
- Identify and embed high impact pedagogy approaches and teaching strategies to support the diverse learning needs of our students.
- Develop staff capabilities as coaches and mentors to support peers

### **Our initiatives include**

- Augmentative and Alternative Communication professional learning and coaching.
- Continue partnership with ROCC team to support staff capability building to interpret data captured within the Roadmap of Communicative Competence (ROCC) diagnostic tool and develop Individualised Student Plans outlining a communication goal, strategies and resources.
- Provide staff with time to undertake intentional collaboration to review the "Rosella Way" approach to whole school pedagogy.
- Embedding high-impact teaching strategies and pedagogy to provide effective learning opportunities for students at Rosella Park School.
- Engage with IMPACT program to drive whole school pedagogy development.
